Publishing Scotland's International Fellowship Programme was established in 2015 to facilitate exchange between international publishers and the publishing sector in Scotland.

We are now looking for 8 publishers to join us in Scotland in 2024 for a packed programme of meetings, market presentations, networking, publisher and agent visits, and more. The Fellowship takes place during a week in August to coincide with the Edinburgh International Book Festival and the world-famous Edinburgh Festival and Fringe. All travel and accommodation costs are paid.

The Fellows will be chosen by a steering committee and emphasis will be placed upon the track record of the publishing company and their previous interest in, and links to, the industry in Scotland. We normally select two publishers working in children's literature, and six working in literature for adults. We aim for a wide spread of countries each year and a balance of larger and smaller publishing houses.
